### Report to Harlow Council

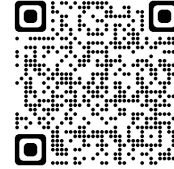

Online reporting form for **antisocial behaviour**



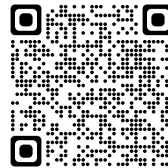
Online reporting form for **noise nuisance**

### Report to the North Essex Parking Partnership (NEPP)

NEPP is a council-run organisation with enforcement capability. They are the lead agency for many parking matters including the administration of parking restrictions and maintenance of residential permit schemes.



### Report to Crimestoppers/Fearless

Crimestoppers is a charity independent from the police, who will take information 100% anonymously, before passing it to the best law enforcement organisation. There is some information Crimestoppers cannot process, such as if the informant is reporting an emergency or is a victim of crime, which will require the police. Fearless is the youth branch of Crimestoppers and works in the same way for young people, with online reporting via [www.fearless.org](http://www.fearless.org)

### Report to Essex Police

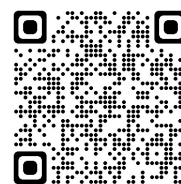
Always dial **999** when: a serious crime is believed in progress or has recently occurred; someone is in immediate danger or harm; property is in danger of being damaged or a serious disruption to the public is likely. There are many ways to report a variety of non-urgent matters online at [www.essex.police.uk](http://www.essex.police.uk), as an alternative to calling **101**. This includes a Live Chat service operated daily between 7am-11pm, with reports dealt with in the same way as when calling 101.

### Report anonymously to StreetSafe

Anonymously tell them about public places where you have felt or feel unsafe because of issues like street lighting, abandoned buildings or vandalism and/or because of behaviours such as being followed or verbally abused.
